**What is the time commitment?** Being on the Board of Directors means attending up to eight board meetings a year that are held before an evening dinner event or around noon during the week, and choosing a committee or project to be involved with. Typically board meetings take a couple hours. Between board meetings you will spend some time on the project or committee so that you can report progress at the next board meeting.

**Are there other ways to get involved?** Yes. If you cannot make time available for a Board of Directors commitment, please consider joining one of our committees.
