Claude Trusty Passes at Age 82

Claude Benson Trusty Jr. passed away on Wednesday, April 20th at the age of 82.



Claude Trusty 1933 - 2016

Claude served as ACI Chapter President in 1978, was involved with ACI for decades, and served most recently as Chapter Audit Committee Chair. He helped institute procedures to more completely identify and report our financial position.

Claude Trusty was born on June 19th 1933 in Memphis, TN. He earned his Bachelor of Science from Northwestern at Memphis in Memphis before joining the US Navy in 1950 and served in Korea. Claude later moved to California where he was a Sherriff for Calaveras County before his career as a structural engineer in the concrete industry began.

In August of 1966, he married Margaret Mary "Peggy" Cushing. Soon afterwards, their son, Claude Benson III, and then their daughter, Patricia Erin arrived.

Claude worked at night to earn his MBA from Golden Gate University and was promoted to Chief Technical Officer with Genstar Cement where he worked until his retirement.

Claude received his private pilot license and enjoyed weekend flights around northern California with the family. Claude's passion for aircraft and railroads consumed his free time. He and Peggy enjoyed traveling and were fortunate to be able to see most of the world.

Sadly, his wife Peggy passed away just 5 months before Claude's passing. A memorial for Claude Trusty was held in Memphis..
