Bowling Ball and Excellent Chapter SJSU ACI Students Get Two Awards

San Jose State University's ACI Student Chapter Team placed second at the "Fiber Reinforced Concrete Bowling Ball" poster international competition.

The competition was hosted by ACI at the ACI Spring Convention in Milwaukee on April 17 and 18. Fifty-seven university teams representing nine countries participated in this competition. Each team was required to submit a poster explaining the theory behind designing and constructing a reinforced concrete bowling ball with fibers to resist certain maximum load before failure. The team consisted of five students from the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering: Diyaree Ismael (Team leader and ACI student chapter president), Rami Zayed (ACI Secretary), Daniel Vasquez (ACI Treasurer), Carlos Murillo (ACI Outreach officer) and James Fok (Lead on poster design).

The SJSU ACI student chapter was also recognized with the ACI Excellent University award at the convention, which is the highest award by American Concrete Institute given to university student chapters.
