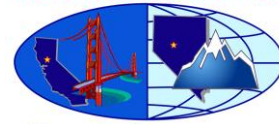

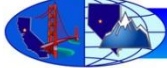

The Shade/Nabben Residence is concrete from the foundation to the roof ridge other than use of decorative wood for architectural appearance and a few steel stud wall partitions. The Integraspec building system is based on polystyrene foam concrete forms that when filled with reinforcement and concrete create a concrete wall insulated on both sides with 2.5" of high density foam.

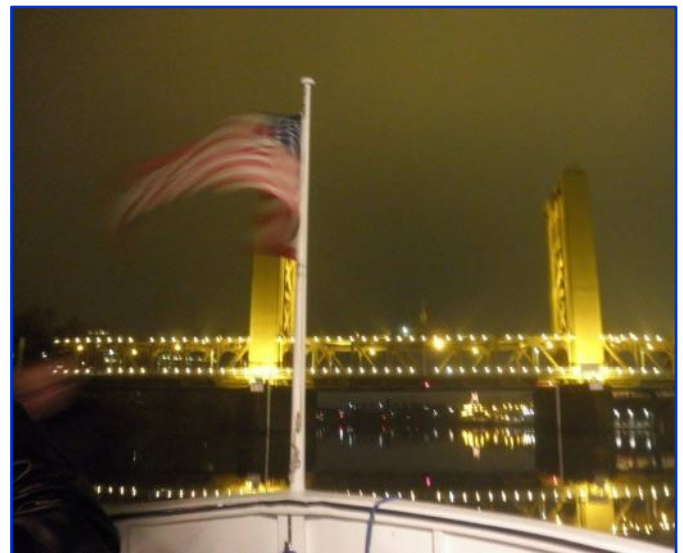
